In the year 1959-60, four year degree programmes were initiated in Textile Technology and Textile Chemistry affiliated with Agra University. It was affiliated to Kanpur University when it came into being in the year 1966.

In the year 1976-77, a four year degree programme in Man Made Fibre Technology was also initiated in the Institute. In the year 1985, the three year diploma courses were transferred to the Government Polytechnic, Kanpur and post graduate, doctoral programs were started in the Institute.

In the year 2005, another four year degree programme in Textile Engineering was started with the help of World Bank under TEQIP (Technical Education Quality Improvement) scheme of Govt. of INDIA.

Thus, our Institute made a remarkable journey of it's development since the inception. Today, it is all equipped with the required paraphernalia for graduate, post graduate and doctoral programmes in the field of textiles.
